

## Shepherd PTO Meeting – December 9, 2020

### ***Meeting called to order at 6:34***

Exec Board: Liz, Taryn, Sara, Andrea, Aryanna

### **Dr. Hedlund Update**

- CARE class began for 9 K's
  - Went off without a hitch
  - Every student wore headphones and used their microphone
  - The challenge if it was multi-grade
- Survey Response (331 responses)
  - 164 virtual only; 129 in-person learning
  - 129 will keep kids home
  - 83 will send even without same teacher
- Breakdown by Grade Level
  - PK3: 13 for in person; 4 CARE/IPL
  - PK4: 20 IPL; 12 VO; 4 either
  - K: 18 IPL, 14VO; 8 either
  - 1<sup>st</sup>: 26 VO; 16 IPL; 1 either
  - 2<sup>nd</sup>: 22 VO; 15 IPL; 4 either
  - 3<sup>rd</sup>: 17 IPL; 13 VO; 1 either
  - 4<sup>th</sup>: 38 VO; 12 IPL; 7 either
  - 5<sup>th</sup>: 35 VO; 17 IPL; 4 either
- Instructional Model
  - A: One Teacher Instructs One Cohort All Week
  - B: One Teacher Instructs Both IPL and V
    - Problem → What if there are problems both in person and on-line
  - C: Two Teachers Rotate 2 IPL and 3 V
    - Shepherd is not looking at this
  - D: One Teacher Instructs 2 Cohorts IPL and V
    - Kids in school 2 days per week
- Re-Opening Community Corp
  - Will have a max of 9 classrooms – 2 are isolation rooms – which is 7 classrooms (1 for K Care)
  - Working on getting 3 other classrooms available
- Panorama
  - 91% feel challenged (1% decrease)
  - 69% feel loved (7% increase)
  - 63% feel prepared (4% decrease)
- Data (Math and ELA)
  - Math – Freeman
    - 66.5% Proficient & Highly Proficient
    - ANET for grades 3-5: 53.6% are proficient
  - ELA Assessments (Moorefield)

- DIBELS, TRC, Reading Inventory, and ANet
- Slight decrease in DIBELS, increase in others

**Question about PARCC**

- Will there be another PARCC waiver?
- Dr. Hedlund said while not official, they are very likely not going to do PARCC again this year.
