

GET READY TO BID!

We are again using <u>Handbid software</u> to run our event and silent auction. Bid directly from your computer or mobile smartphone from Tuesday, May 14th, until 9:30PM on the night of the event. Handbid also makes it possible for Shepherd supporters who are unable to attend the event to join in the bidding fun as well!

Download the Handbid Application for <u>iOS</u> or <u>Android</u>

If you are already registered in the system, use your web login to access the application. Make sure you have associated your credit card number with your bidder account so that you will be able to place bids. Rest assured, your credit card information is secure; it is not stored (or accessible) by the organization or Handbid. It is stored directly with the payment processor (Stripe).

2

Bring your smartphone to the event

Make sure it is fully charged so you can use your phone to make bids throughout the night.

3

Check-in for the event

If you are registered in the system, you have already been assigned a unique bidder number. If not, when you check-in at the event, one of the check-in staff will help you to register to bid at that time. We'll also give you a bid card with your unique bidder number for use during "appeal" for the IB Passport and Operations Fund later in the evening.

4

Check out our silent auction items

Grab a cocktail and peruse the silent auction items on display at the event. Full descriptions of each item are available on Handbid. Silent auction items will be available until 9:30 PM, at which time all categories will close simultaneously.

5

Log in and start bidding!

You can also purchase "for sale" items, such as tickets for sign-up parties, or donate money directly through the Handbid system.



"Settle up" before you leave the event

Once the silent auction closes, you can pay for all of your items directly within the Handbid app using your credit card on file. If you wish to pay with cash or check instead of using the credit card on file in the Handbid system, please let a Gala staff member know so we can process the payment. All items must be paid for in full at the conclusion of the auction. If you are onsite at Jinya and won a displayed item, you can show your paid invoice to a Gala staff member and take the item home at the end of the night.


